





WP1: Overall aim

To develop a strategy for improving scientific excellence and innovation capacity of BIPH in the field of cellular and molecular neuroscience

WP1: Key objectives

1. To train early career BIPH researchers in up-to-date experimental neuroscience methods and protocols

2. To improve BIPH staff skills in writing up research reports, presenting research results, and establishing collaborations

3. To assist BIPH research staff with planning and formulating scientific tasks and the research strategies involved

Task 1: Knowledge Transfer Committee

Composition: Participating team members, in liaison with PGM Department and PMT

Main activity: Program of workshops and seminars. Up to four workshops planned: Months 3, 16, 35

Task 2: Workshop planning and organisation

Workshop 1 (Month 3, three days, participation 70): First working meeting, familiarisation with BIPH, researcher training on novel methods.

Workshop 2 (Month 16, five days, participation 70): Onsite training in research protocol design and planning.

Workshop 3 (Month 35, three days, participation 70): Porgress reporting, training on research reporting, presentation, and proposal design.

Task 3: Research staff exchange

Activities: Short-term visits (1-2 weeks) by research staff, mainly from and to BIPH, for hands-on training and tutoring

Plan: 13-16 visits over three years

Task 4: Experts visit

Activities: Arranging lectures and seminars at BIPH delivered by world authorities in the field of neuroscience

Plan: Six visits a year, 18 in total. To be broadcast as webinars. A specialised website to be arranged.

Task 5: Research meetings and conferences

Activities: Arranging attendance of major neuroscience forums for BIPH (early career) research staff, with designated presentations

Plan: At least 30 presentations. Attendance: SfN 2019, 2020, 2021, FENS 2020, some specialised conferences. Early career researchers will outnumber senior ones as attendees.
